

The Following Dickey County Offices will be on the 2022 County Election Ballot:

Commissioner District 1 (Includes Northwest, Young, Potsdam, German, Whitestone, Hamburg, Spring Valley, Grand Valley, Albion, Elden, Kentner, Albertha, Lorraine, Elm, and Ellendale Townships, the city of Forbes, and that portion of the city of Ellendale that lies North of Highway 11 and west of Highway 281)

Commissioner District 3 (Includes Valley, Porter, Wright, James River Valley, Keystone, Maple, Yorktown, Clement, Kent, Hudson, Riverdale, Van Meter, Ada, Port Emma, and Lovell Townships, and the cities of Monango, Fullerton, and Ludden)

Commissioner District 5 (Includes Divide and Bear Creak Townships and that portion of the city of Oakes lying North of Main Avenue and West of 14<sup>th</sup> Street)
