## Commissioner Meeting November 20, 2018

Commissioner Joel Hamar called the meeting to order at 9:50. Present were Thor Sand, John Hokana, Marke Roberts, Dean Simek and Chairman Joel Hamar. States Attorney Jeff Glynn was also present. The media was not present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Hokana made a motion to approve the minutes from the October 30<sup>th</sup> meeting. Roberts seconded. Motion carried.

Sand made a motion to approve the vouchers. Simek seconded. Motion carried.

Deputy Treasurer Cheryl Brokaw, Highway Superintendent Jeff Hagen, and DES/911 Coordinator Charlie Russell joined the meeting at 10:00.

Simek made a motion to approve the financials for October 2018. Hokana seconded. Motion carried.

Kadrmas Lee and Jackson Project Manager Jason Manlove joined the meeting at 10:05.

A phone call from NRCS had been received concerning a ditch that needs to be filled in. The property is on Roy Miller's property. The drain was originally put in to assist in decreasing water in a slough along Dickey County #3 during a year of flooding. NRCS wants the drain filled in or installation of drain tile, which would have to be at the expense of the landowner. Clarification from NRCS may be helpful to make a decision. A decision was not made at this time.

Sheriff Chris Estes joined the meeting at 10:07.

The selection of an engineering firm for the bridge projects on County Road 8 needs to be made. A memo received from the selection committee was read at the meeting. The committee of Thor Sand, Dean Simek, and Jeff Hagen stated the two firms were both the same when rated. They however felt the issues brought up by Interstate Engineering may save the county some money, along with less time of road closure. The recommendation from the committee is to hire Interstate Engineering for the construction engineering of this project. Based on the recommendation of selection committee, Hokana made a motion for the commission to select Interstate Engineering to complete the construction engineering for the BRC-1100(020) bridge project. Roberts seconded. Discussion followed concerning the current working relationship that Dickey County has with KLJ and the effect this decision could make on that relationship. Manlove stated that any change on the project would have to go through design engineering. No dollar or time savings was quantified during the discussion with Interstate Engineering. Project Engineer Ben Aaseth with Interstate Engineering joined the meeting at 10:35. Roll call vote to hire Interstate Engineering was Sand yes, Hokana yes, Roberts yes, Simek no, Hamar no. Motion carried.

Simek made a motion to open the 2018 Tax sale. Sand seconded. Motion carried. Ellendale City Auditor Candy Middlestead and Tax Director Don Flaherty joined the meeting.

Auditor Sheppard read the posting of the sale. There is one item for sale. The legal description on the property is Lot 11 Block 29 First Addition Ellendale. The minimum bid is \$2,160.12. No bids were received. All other property had been paid in full before November 20, 2018.

Simek made a motion to close the land sale. Roberts seconded. Motion carried.

Sand made a motion to deed the property from the land sale, Lot 11 Block 29 First Addition Ellendale, to Ellendale city. Roberts seconded. Motion carried.

Simek made a motion to abate the taxes on the property, Parcel #08059000 to the City of Ellendale. Hokana seconded. Motion carried. Ellendale City will make a motion at their next Council meeting to request an abatement of specials on the property at their December meeting.

Sheppard presented the County Federal Aid Contract and the Contract Bond for the bridge project in 2019, which need to be signed by the States Attorney, Auditor, and Commissioner Chairman. Roberts made a motion to sign the contracts. Sand seconded. Motion carried.

Brokaw presented a request to cash in two CDs at BankNorth that are maturing on November 19, 2018 and the purchase of two new CDs. BankNorth is offering a 12-month CD at 1.65% yield or 2.21% for a 14-month CD. The face value on the CDs are \$100,000 and \$300,000. Hokana made a motion to cash out the two CDS and to purchase two 14-month CDs. Simek seconded. Motion carried.

An amended contract for transfer of all or some municipal court ordinance cases to district court for the city of Ellendale has been received. Roberts made a motion to sign the contract. Sand seconded. Motion carried.

A revised proposal has been received for the back door at the county shop in the amount of \$1,425 to put panic bar hardware on the door only. Commission asked Russell to check with Dickey Rural Networks about the effect of this change on the security system in the building.

Manlove gave an update on the seal coat project for 2019. The bid opening for that project will be in March. Manlove also stated that final payment on the road project this year should be finalized by the end of the year.

Sheppard presented a Quit Claim Deed for parcel #07826000, as the taxes were paid in full before the tax sale. Simek made a motion to sign the deed. Sand seconded. Motion carried.

Commission and Estes spoke about issues with overloaded trucks. Estes stated they have been short staffed, as well as busy with domestic disputes lately. Pictures were shared of trucks and how overloaded they have been. The new deputy starting December 2<sup>nd</sup> worked in Dunn County and has been trained on overweight trucks.

Estes presented a new contract with Stutsman County for Jail services for 2019. The fee will increase from \$65/day to \$70/day. Glynn reviewed the contract and stated it was okay to sign. Sand made a motion to sign the contract. Simek seconded. Motion carried. Estes would like Glynn to look into the possibility of contracting with Brown County.

Estes asked for an extension of the due date for using vacation time to March 31<sup>st</sup>. Sheppard stated there were other departments that had issues, as well. Roberts made a motion to extend the date to March 31<sup>st</sup> for all employees. Hokana seconded. Motion carried. Sheppard will send out an e-mail informing all employees.

Risk Manager Cresta Miller joined the meeting at 11:25 to update the Commission on the training all employees were to take last week. There will be a link to the presentation for employees unable to watch earlier. Miller will inform the Commission when the link is updated.

Hokana made a motion to adjourn at 11:30.
