## Commissioner Meeting January 15, 2019

Commissioner Joel Hamar called the meeting to order at 9:30. Present were Thor Sand, John Hokana, Marke Roberts, Dean Simek and Chairman Joel Hamar. The media was not present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Additions to the minutes

Tree set back

Committee to rewrite bylaws of JDA

Roberts made a motion to approve the Minutes from December 18<sup>th</sup> and December 27<sup>th</sup> with corrections. Sand seconded. Motion carried.

Simek made a motion to approve the December 2018 Financials. Sand seconded. Motion carried.

Simek made a motion to sign the contract with Fullerton City for the transfer of all or some municipal court ordinance cases to District Court. Hokana seconded. Motion carried

A revised copy of the agreement with Elm Township concerning the maintenance of Pheasant Lake Road has been signed by Elm Township and needs a signature by the Chairman. Discussion followed concerning the specifics of the contract and what was covered. By September 1<sup>st</sup>, the contract should be submitted to Elm Township to include a map, showing that the covered area stops at the section line. Simek made a motion to sign the agreement. Sand seconded. Motion carried.

Hokana made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 9:50.

Sheppard opened the meeting to reorganize the Commission Board for 2019.

Sheppard asked for nominations for Commissioner Chairman for 2019. Simek made a motion to appoint Hamar. Hokana seconded. Simek made a motion to cease nominations and cast a unanimous ballot for Hamar. Hokana seconded. Motion carried.

Hamar asked for nominations for Vice Chairman. Simek nominated Roberts. Sand seconded the nomination. Simek made a motion to cease nominations and cast a unanimous ballot for Roberts. Hokana seconded. Motion carried.

Portfolio assignments for 2019 were discussed. Roberts made a motion to continue with the same portfolios and add Hamar on the Social Services & Health District portfolio. Sand seconded. Motion carried.

A list of current board appointments was reviewed. Sheppard will post in the newspaper for open positions. A letter will also be sent out to those currently serving to inform them of the notice and to request information from them if they would consider continuing on the Board

Simek made a motion to approve the vouchers. Sand seconded. Motion carried.

Sheppard presented a Beer License application and a Retail Liquor application from the Ellendale Country Club for 2019. Roberts made a motion to approve the licenses. Sand seconded. Motion carried.

Treasurer Gail Veland joined the meeting at 10:15. Veland presented the Treasurer's Quarterly report. Hokana made a motion to accept the report and for Chairman Hamar to sign. Simek seconded. Motion carried.

County Agent Breana Kiser and States Attorney Jeff Glynn joined the meeting at 10:18.

Kiser informed the Commission that her annual review will be at 10:00 am January 30<sup>th</sup>. Kiser also informed the Commission that the staff from James River Soil Conservation had asked about using space in the County Agent's office, if they could not use their own office space after the office is closed due to the federal government shut down. Simek made a motion to allow Soil Conservation staff to use office space in the Extension office at no cost. This will be reevaluated if need be at a later date. Roberts seconded. Motion carried.

Glynn is requesting additional hours for his Administrative Assistant, who is currently part time. The current case load is requiring more time for both of them. The former States Attorney Gary Neuharth has offered to help out as Glynn feels is necessary. Sand made a motion pay the Administrative Assistant full time through July 1<sup>st</sup> and then reevaluate it at that time. Simek seconded. Sheppard will work with the staff to ensure everything is done according to the law. Overtime, if any, will be paid by the week. Motion carried. The case load is also requiring extra time of the States Attorney. Sand made a motion to pay Glynn at full time wages for the month of January and February. Hokana seconded. Motion carried

Roberts made a motion to appoint Gary Neuharth as the Assistant States Attorney and approve payment of \$1,500 for the next month. Simek seconded. Motion carried.

Sheriff Chris Estes, Highway Superintendent Jeff Hagen, and ND DES/911 Coordinator Charlie Russell joined the meeting at 11:15.

Estes is requesting approval for the hiring of additional deputies during the jury trial in February. Courtroom security and prisoner transports will require more assistance than the department currently has. Roberts made a motion to allow Estes, at his discretion, to hire additional deputy help for the trial. Simek seconded. Motion carried. Estes will also be sending out information to all employees about the use of name badges and security for the courthouse during that time frame.

Sheppard presented the Construction and Maintenance Agreement for the seal coat project for 2019 to be signed by the Chairman, Auditor, and State's Attorney. The total cost of the project is \$703,100, with the county's share to be approximately \$134,081. Simek made a motion to sign the agreement. Sand seconded. Motion carried. -

Sand asked Hagen concerning the tree planting set back issue discussed at the December 18<sup>th</sup> meeting. Hagen had researched other county set back requirements. After reviewing the request, Commission are asking for more information from land owner as to the requested distance. Hagen will also check the distance on the trees on the next property for the distance they were planted.

Hagen stated that Interstate Engineering will be here with contract for the bridge project at the February 5<sup>th</sup> Commissioner meeting.

Sheppard presented a Mutual Aid Agreement received from McIntosh County. Hokana made a motion to sign the agreement. Simek seconded. Motion carried.

Sheppard presented a Quit claim Deed for parcel number 08059000. This parcel was not sold at the county sale in November and this deed is giving the parcel back to the city of Ellendale. Simek made a motion to have the Chairman and Auditor sign the deed. Roberts seconded. Motion carried.

The yearly contract for maintenance with Software Innovations was presented for approval. Sand motioned to sign the agreement. Hokana seconded. Motion carried.

Sheppard presented budget amendments for 2018, as shown below. Sand made a motion to approve the budget amendments. Simek seconded. Motion carried.

Sand reported to the Commission that there is a committee formed through the Job Development Authority (JDA) Board to review the bylaws of the JDA. Director Stacy Bowerman with South Central Dakota Regional Council is assisting the Committee. Sand covered what North Dakota Century Code states concerning the powers of the JDA. Sand requested information from the other Commissioners about their concerns and thoughts about JDA.
